WHEREAS, the Colorado State Archives has developed a state-wide record retention schedule in cooperation with the Colorado Special Districts Association, the Colorado Attorney General's Office and the State Auditor's Office for special districts to use follow; and

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Directors of the Black Forest Fire/Rescue Protection District, that it hereby adopts the 2008 Colorado Special District Records Retention Schedule and all subsequent revisions, and authorizes the District Secretary to Submit the request to be used as legal authority for the destruction and preservation of district records to the Colorado State Archives on behalf of the district.
